- October went from 25° to 90° with some days in the high 40's. There has been some record highs for this time of year. Temperatures for the most part right now are high 40's at night to high 60's and 70's in the day. Rain for the month was only .5 inches with a few traces here and there.
- Pneumonia cases increased at the beginning of the month but have fallen off this past week or two. It took us awhile to get over the stress from the change in IBR and other injections at arrival. We have since changed our arrival program to a minimal amount of injections. Some heifers took it pretty hard. We had about three weeks worth of heifers that went through this change.

## From Justin's Desk:

- In October we received a little over 2700 heifers and shipped about 2200. We got in some local pregnant heifers so this is why our incoming numbers are up. We finally finished up our sorghum harvest at the beginning of November. 100% of our wheat, oats and milo silage were put up on site at Arroyo Seco. We cut over 25,000 tons of milo this harvest as our yields were higher than expected.
